Chapter 19

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE) ACT, NO. 2, 2010-2011

(Assented to June 10, 2010)

Whereas it appears by message from the Commissioner and from the estimates accompanying the message, that the amounts set out in the Schedule to this Act are required to defray expenses of the Government of Nunavut and for other purposes connected with the Government of Nunavut for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2011;

Therefore, the Commissioner of Nunavut, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows:

Definitions

1. The definitions in section 1 of the *Financial Administration Act* apply to this Act.

Application

2. This Act applies to the fiscal year ending on March 31, 2011.

Reduction of appropriation

3. Despite the amounts authorized by the *Appropriation (Operations and Maintenance) Act, 2010-2011* and the *Supplementary Appropriation (Operations and Maintenance) Act, No. 1, 2010-2011*, where an amount is set out in parenthesis for an item in the Schedule, the aggregate amount authorized to be expended in respect of the item is reduced by the amount in parenthesis.

Lapse of appropriation

4. Subject to sections 36 and 37 of the *Financial Administration Act*, the authority in this Act to make expenditures for the purposes and in the amounts set out in the Schedule expires on March 31, 2011.

Accounting

5. Amounts expended under the authority of this Act shall be accounted for in the Public Accounts in accordance with sections 72 and 73 of the *Financial Administration Act*.

Commencement

6. This Act is deemed to have come into force on April 1, 2010.
