## Chapter 20

#### LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY STATUTES AMENDMENT ACT

(Assented to November 5, 2015)

The Commissioner of Nunavut, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows:

#### PART I

### LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY RETIRING ALLOWANCES ACT

- 1. (1) This section amends the Legislative Assembly Retiring Allowances Act.
  - (2) The following is added after section 3:

#### Exclusion – suspension

**3.1.** If a member is suspended from the Legislative Assembly by a majority vote, the member's service is not to include the period that begins on the day on which the suspension starts and ends on the day fixed by a majority vote of the Legislative Assembly for the reinstatement of the member's entitlement to accrue pensionable service.

## Effect of suspension

**3.2.** Despite any provision of this Act, no contribution shall be paid by a member in respect of any period referred to in section 3.1.

### SUPPLEMENTARY RETIRING ALLOWANCES ACT

- 2. (1) This section amends the Supplementary Retiring Allowances Act.
  - (2) The following is added after section 3:

#### Exclusion – suspension

**3.1.** If a member is suspended from the Legislative Assembly by a majority vote, the member's service is not to include the period that begins on the day on which the suspension starts and ends on the day fixed by a majority vote of the Legislative Assembly for the reinstatement of the member's entitlement to accrue pensionable service.

## Effect of suspension

- **3.2.** Despite any provision of this Act, no contribution shall be paid by a member in respect of any period referred to in section 3.1.
  - (3) The following is added after 7:

## Suspension

**7.1.** A period referred to in section 3.1 is not to be included in the determination of the time limit for making an election under section 7.

#### PART II

# OFFICIAL LANGUAGES ACT

- 3. (1) This section amends the Official Languages Act.
- (2) Subsection 16(4) is amended by striking out "four" and substituting "five".
- (3) Subsection 20.1(1) is amended by striking out "may appoint" and substituting "may appoint, following a competition,"
  - (4) The following is added after subsection 20.1(1):

# Exception

- (1.1) Despite subsection (1), the Languages Commissioner may appoint staff without a competition with the approval of the Management and Services Board.
- (5) For greater certainty, subsection (2) does not modify the term of the appointment of the Languages Commissioner in office at the time of the coming into force of this section.

## REPRESENTATIVE FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH ACT

- 4. (1) This section amends the Representative for Children and Youth Act.
- (2) Subsection 13(2) is amended by striking out ", if, in the opinion of the Representative, it is necessary to do so." and substituting " with the approval of the Management and Services Board.".
