

### Chapter 3

## BOARDS OF MANAGEMENT DISSOLUTION ACT

*(Assented to June 3, 1999)*

The Commissioner of Nunavut, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows:

#### Definition

1. In this Act,

"Board of Management" means a Board of Management within the meaning of the *Hospital Insurance and Health and Social Services Administration Act*.

#### Dissolution of Board of Management

2. On April 1, 2000, each Board of Management is dissolved.

#### Interim trustee

3. (1) Before April 1, 2000, the Minister may, with the approval of the Executive Council, appoint an interim trustee for a Board of Management if the Minister is of the opinion that it is advisable for the purposes of facilitating the dissolution of the Board.

#### Powers and duties

(2) The interim trustee for a Board of Management may exercise the powers of the Board and shall perform the duties of the Board and may allow the Board to exercise any or all of those powers or perform any or all of those duties, subject to the supervision of the interim trustee.

#### Liability of interim trustee

(3) An interim trustee is not liable for loss or damage caused by anything done or not done by him or her in good faith in the exercise of his or her powers or the performance of his or her duties.

#### Restriction on Boards incurring obligations

4. Except with the Minister's approval, a Board of Management shall not incur an obligation that extends, or may extend, beyond March 31, 2000.
