Chapter 14

INTERIM APPROPRIATION (CAPITAL) ACT, 2022-2023

(Assented to June 8, 2021)

Whereas it appears by message from the Commissioner and from the estimates accompanying the message, that the amounts set out in the Schedule to this Act are required to defray the capital expenses of the Government of Nunavut for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2023;

Therefore, the Commissioner of Nunavut, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows:

Definitions

1. The definitions in section 1 of the *Financial Administration Act* apply to this Act.

Application

2. This Act applies to the fiscal year ending on March 31, 2023.

Appropriation

3. (1) Expenditures may be made, in accordance with the *Financial Administration Act*, for the purposes and in the amounts set out in the Schedule.

Maximum amount

(2) The total amount of all expenditures made under the authority of this Act must not exceed \$37,873,000.

Lapse of appropriation

4. Subject to sections 36 and 37 of the *Financial Administration Act*, the authority in this Act to make expenditures for the purposes and in the amounts set out in the Schedule expires on March 31, 2023.

Accounting

5. The amounts expended under the authority of this Act shall be accounted for in the Public Accounts in accordance with sections 72 and 73 of the *Financial Administration Act*.

Act ceases to have effect

6. On the enactment of a statute entitled *Appropriation (Capital) Act, 2022-2023*, expenditures made under the authority of this Act shall be deemed to have been made under the authority of that Act, and this Act shall cease to have effect.
