NUNAVUMMI NANGMINIAQTUNIK IKAJUUTI REGULATIONS, amendment

The Commissioner in Executive Council, on the recommendation of the Financial Management Board, under subsection 5(1) of the *Nunavummi Nangminiaqtunik Ikajuuti Implementation Act*, S.Nu. 2017,c.13, and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendment to the *Nunavummi Nangminiaqtunik Ikajuuti Regulations*, Nu.Reg. R-007-2017.

1. These regulations amend the *Nunavummi Nangminiaqtunik Ikajuuti Regulations*, Nu.Reg. R-007-2017.

2. The Schedule is amended

- (a) **in paragraph 7.10(b) by deleting "minor or major";**
- (b) **by adding the following after section 7.10:**

7.10.1 For Procurement Processes for Major Construction,

- (a) the maximum cumulative Bid Adjustment of the following provisions shall not exceed \$500,000 ("The Bid Adjustment Cap for Major Construction"):
 - (i) section 17.1,
 - (ii) section 25.2, with respect to the portion of the Bid Adjustment determined using Nunavut Labour that is not also Inuit Labour,
 - (iii) section 25.3, with respect to the portion of the Bid Adjustment determined using Local Labour that is not also Inuit Labour, and
- (b) for greater certainty, the Bid Adjustment Cap for Major Construction shall not apply to Minor Construction.
- (c) **in Appendix A by**
 - (i) **adding "The Bid Adjustment Cap for Major Construction is \$500,000." at the end of the definition of Bid Adjustment Cap, and**
 - (ii) **adding the following definitions in alphabetical order:**

Major Construction – construction procurement valued at more than \$250,000.

Minor Construction – construction procurement valued at no more than \$250,000.

Transitional

3. The regulations as they read prior to the coming into force of these regulations apply with respect to all procurement processes issued before the coming into force of these regulations and to all contracts resulting from those procurement processes.

Coming into force

4. These regulations come into force on the later of February 1, 2021 and the day on which they are registered by the Registrar of Regulations.
