**PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS, amendment**

The Commissioner, on the recommendation of the Minister, under section 49 of the *Public Service Act* and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendment to the *Public Service Regulations*, R.R.N.W.T. 1990, c.P-28, as duplicated for Nunavut by section 29 of the *Nunavut Act*.

**1. The *Public Service Regulations*, R.R.N.W.T. 1990, c.P-28, as duplicated for Nunavut by section 29 of the *Nunavut Act*, are amended by these regulations.**

**2. The English version of subsection 1(1) is amended by**

- (a) **striking out "employee's" in the definition "grievance" and substituting "employees"; and**
- (b) **striking out "that" in the definition "part-time employee" and substituting "than".**

**3. Section 9 is amended by striking out "The Deputy Minister" and substituting "A deputy head".**

**4. The English version of section 11 is amended by adding "be" after "declared to".**

**5. The following is added immediately before section 17 and after the heading "Pay":**

**16.** The Deputy Minister of the department responsible for the Act may, within 12 months after the appointment of an employee to the public service, grant a salary adjustment for an employee who is a senior manager, but the salary adjustment may not exceed 25% of the employee's former rate of pay.

**6. The following is added after section 29:**

Medical Travel Leave

**29.1.** (1) An employee, who is referred by a medical practitioner, nurse practitioner or nurse for medical services at a health facility outside the community in which the employee resides, may, with the approval of a deputy head, be granted leave of absence with pay for the lesser of

- (a) three days; or
- (b) the actual time taken to travel between the community in which the employee resides and the health facility.

(2) In this section,

"medical practitioner" means a medical practitioner as defined in the *Medical Care Act*; (*médecin*)

"nurse practitioner" means a nurse practitioner as defined in the *Nursing Act*. (*infirmière praticienne ou infirmier praticien*)

**7. Subsection 30(1) is amended by striking out "6 weeks" and substituting "30 days".**

**8. The English version of subsection 33(3) is amended by adding "an" after "granted to".**

- 9. Section 38 is amended by striking out "Deputy Minister" and substituting "deputy head".**
- 10. (1) Section 45 is amended by striking out "Deputy Minister" wherever it appears and substituting "deputy head".**
- (2) The English version of subsection 45(1) is amended by striking out "capable or being" and substituting "capable of being".**
- 11. Paragraph 49(h) is repealed and the following substituted:**
- (h) chief executive officers and presidents of public agencies, as defined in the *Financial Administration Act*;
