ACCESS TO INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY REGULATIONS, amendment

The Commissioner in Executive Council, under section 73 of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* and every enabling power, orders as follows:

1. The *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Regulations*, registered under the *Statutory Instruments Act* (Northwest Territories) as regulation numbered R-206-96, as duplicated for Nunavut by section 29 of the *Nunavut Act*, are amended by these regulations.
2. Schedule A is repealed and Schedule A as set out in the schedule to these regulations is substituted.
3. These regulations come into force on the day on which they are registered with the Registrar of Regulations.
