INTERPRETATION ACT

DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME REGULATIONS, 2001

The Commissioner, on the recommendation of the Minister of Justice, under section 46 of the *Interpretation Act* and every enabling power, orders as follows:

- 1. (1) Daylight Saving Time shall be used and observed every year between
 - (a) 2 a.m. on the first Sunday in April, and
 - (b)2 a.m. on the last Sunday in October.
 - (2)Subsection (1) does not apply to Southampton Island and the islands adjacent to Southampton Island.
- (3) In this section, "Daylight Saving Time" means the time one hour in advance of the local standard time set out in the *Interpretation Act*.
- **2.** The *Time Zone and Daylight Saving Time Regulations*, R-045-99, are repealed.
- **3.** These regulations come into force on the later of
 - (a) the time that An Act to Amend the Interpretation Act (Time Zones) comes into force, and
 - (b) the day on which they are registered with the Registrar of Regulations.
