GRISE FIORD SPECIAL PROHIBITION ORDER

WHEREAS Hamlet Council of Grise Fiord has, by resolution, requested that the Minister declare that the Hamlet of Grise Fiord is a prohibited area during the special occasion known as The Alcohol Free Christmas Celebration;

The Minister, under subsection 51.1(2) of the *Liquor Act* and every enabling power, orders as follows:

- 1. All that portion of Nunavut that lies within the boundaries of the hamlet of Grise Fiord is declared to be a prohibited area for the period commencing at 10:00 a.m. on December 23, 1999 and ending at 11:59 p.m. on January 1, 2000.
- 2. No person shall, during the period referred to in section 1, consume, purchase, sell or transport liquor within the prohibited area referred to in section 1.
- 3. These regulations apply according to their terms before they are published in the *Nunavut Gazette*.
