# Chapter 13

## WRITE-OFF OF ASSETS ACT, 2021-2022

(Assented to November 8, 2022)

The Commissioner, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows:

## Write-off of assets

1. The assets of the Nunavut Housing Corporation that are listed in Part 1 of the Schedule are written off.

#### Write-down of assets

**2.** The assets of the Nunavut Housing Corporation that are listed in Part 2 of the Schedule are written down.

## Write-off of assets

**3.** The assets of the Government of Nunavut that are listed in Part 3 of the Schedule are written off.

#### Write-off of assets

4. The assets of the Government of Nunavut that are listed in Part 4 of the Schedule are written off.
