ELECTIONS REGULATIONS, amendment

The Management and Services Board, under section 217 of the *Nunavut Elections Act* and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendments to the *Elections Regulations*.

- 1. These regulations amend the *Elections Regulations*.**
- 2. Section 4 is repealed and replaced by:**
 4. (1) The writ of election must contain the information described under Form 2 in the Schedule.
 - (2) The Chief Electoral Officer may approve the form of the writ of election.
- 3. Form 2 in the Schedule is repealed and replaced by Form 2 in the Schedule to these regulations.**

SCHEDULE

(section 2)

FORM 2

WRIT OF ELECTION

1. The front of the form of the writ of election must include
 - (a) the name and title of the Commissioner;
 - (b) the Royal Style and Titles of the Sovereign;
 - (c) in the case of a general election, a statement that the Legislative Assembly has terminated or been dissolved and that the Commissioner has instructed the issue of writ for the election of members;
 - (d) a command to the returning officer to cause
 - (i) an election to be held in the constituency,
 - (ii) the filing of declarations of candidacy to close at a specified date and time,
 - (iii) if an election becomes necessary, that the election be held on a specified date,
 - (iv) the name of the elected member to be certified to the Chief Electoral Officer, in accordance with the Act;
 - (e) in the case of a general election, the date by which the certification referred to in paragraph (d)(iv) must be done;
 - (f) the date of the writ; and
 - (g) the title of the Chief Electoral Officer.

2. The reverse of the form of the writ of election must contain the return of the writ, which must include
 - (a) the name of the constituency;
 - (b) the date of the election or, if there was no election, an indication that a member was elected by acclamation;
 - (c) the name and civic address of the elected member as provided on their declaration of candidacy;
 - (d) the date of the return of the writ;
 - (e) the signature of the returning officer; and
 - (f) a record of receipt of the return of the writ to be dated and signed by the Chief Electoral Officer.
