EATING OR DRINKING PLACES REGULATIONS, amendment

The Commissioner in Executive Council, on the recommendation of the Minister, under section 85 of the *Public Health Act* and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendments to the *Eating and Drinking Places Regulations*.

1. **These regulations amend the *Eating or Drinking Places Regulations*,**
2. **The regulations are renamed the *Tent and Outpost Camps Food Safety Regulations*.**
3. **Section 1 is amended by repealing the definition of "eating or drinking place" and adding the following definition in alphabetical order:**

"tent or outpost camp" means a tent camp or outpost camp as defined in the *Tourist Establishment Regulations* made under the *Tourism Act* where food or drink is prepared, cooked, stored, or served;

4. **The following provisions are amended by replacing "eating or drinking place" with "tent or outpost camp" wherever it appears:**
 - (a) **paragraph (a) of the definition of "employee" in section 1;**
 - (b) **the definition of "operator" in section 1;**
 - (c) **section 7;**
 - (d) **section 8;**
 - (e) **section 9;**
 - (f) **section 10;**
 - (g) **section 13, including paragraph (e);**
 - (h) **section 15;**
 - (i) **section 21, including paragraph (g);**
 - (j) **section 27;**
 - (k) **section 29.**

5. **Section 2 is repealed.**

6. **Section 3 is repealed and replaced by:**

3. A person must not operate a tent or outpost camp that does not meet the requirements of these regulations.

7. **These regulations come into force on the day subsection 50(5) of the Act comes into force.**
