**ACCESS TO INFORMATION AND  
PROTECTION OF PRIVACY REGULATIONS, amendment**

The Commissioner in Executive Council, under section 73 of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* and every enabling power, makes the attached amendments to the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Regulations*.

1. **These regulations amend the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Regulations*.**
2. **The English version of paragraph 1(3)(b) is amended by replacing "Responsible" with "responsible".**
3. **Schedule A is repealed and replaced by Schedule A in the Schedule to these regulations.**
4. **On the coming into force of Section 45 of the *Apprenticeship and Certification Act*, item 1 of Schedule A is repealed and replaced by:**
  1. Apprenticeship and Certification Board as continued by the *Apprenticeship and Certification Act* Minister responsible for the *Apprenticeship and Certification Act*
