LOTTERIES REGULATIONS, amendment

The Commissioner in Executive Council, under section 4 of the *Lotteries Act* and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendments to the *Lotteries Regulations*.

- 1. These regulations amend the *Lotteries Regulations*, R.R.N.W.T. 1990,c.L-49.**
- 2. Subsection 5(1) is repealed and replaced by**
 5. (1) An application for a lottery licence must be on a form approved by the Minister and must, not less than one month before the proposed lottery date, be submitted
 - (a) to the person designated by the Minister under section 2 of these regulations; or
 - (b) if there is no person designated, to the Minister.
- 3. Paragraph 9(1)(g) is amended by deleting "at the address stated in section 5".**
- 4. Subsection 9(3) is amended by replacing "set out" with "described".**
- 5. The following is added after subsection 9(3):**
 - (4) The Minister may, for the purposes of the Act,
 - (a) approve Form 1 that is described in the Schedule; and
 - (b) include on Form 1 any additional instructions for the benefit of those who are filling out the form.
- 6. The Schedule is repealed and replaced with the Schedule set out in the Appendix to these regulations.**

APPENDIX

SCHEDULE

FORM 1

(Subsection 9(3))

LICENCE

1. The form for a lottery licence must
 - (a) provide for the following information to be entered:
 - (i) the lottery licence number,
 - (ii) the name of the licence holder,
 - (iii) the type of lottery scheme that the licence holder is authorized to conduct,
 - (iv) the place at which the lottery scheme may be conducted;
 - (b) indicate that the Minister or a person designated by the Minister authorizes, under the *Lotteries Act* and section 207 of the *Criminal Code*, the licence holder to conduct a lottery scheme that does not involve and is not related to
 - (i) a dice game,
 - (ii) three-card monte,
 - (iii) a punch board, or
 - (iv) a coin table;
 - (c) indicate that it is a condition of the licence that the proceeds of the lottery scheme, after deducting the expenses of conducting the lottery scheme, must be donated or applied to
 - (i) the charitable or religious objects or purposes specified in the application; or
 - (ii) charitable or religious objects or purposes expressly authorized by the Minister;
 - (d) indicate the requirement that the licence holder must, within 30 days of the awarding of the prizes of the lottery, submit a statement of account showing total receipts, expenses and profits and indicating when and how such profits will be spent for the approved charitable or religious objects or purposes;
 - (e) include the address to which the statement of account must be sent;
 - (f) provide for the entry of additional terms and restrictions to which the licence is subject;
 - (g) provide for the following to be entered:
 - (i) the signature of the Minister or a person designated by the Minister,
 - (ii) the location at which the licence was signed,
 - (iii) the date on which the licence was signed.

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
