### Chapter 12

## AN ACT TO AMEND THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY AND EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ACT

(Assented to November 30, 2001)

The Commissioner of Nunavut, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows:

1. The Legislative Assembly and Executive Council Act is amended by this Act.

# 2. Section 23 is amended by adding the following subsections after subsection (6):

(7) Where, by virtue of a collective agreement, the rates of pay of public servants mentioned in paragraph 41(1.4)(a) of the *Public Service Act* are globally increased or decreased by a certain percentage, the Speaker, on the recommendation of the Management and Services Board, may, by regulation, increase or decrease the rate of the indemnity payable under subsection (1) by the same percentage.

(8) A regulation made under subsection (7) may come into force before the regulation is made.

### **3.** Subsection 24(1) is repealed and the following substituted:

Additional indemnities

(1) In addition to any other amounts payable under this Act, an indemnity shall be paid at a prescribed rate to:

- (a) the Premier;
- (b) a Minister other than the Premier;
- (c) the Speaker;
- (d) the Deputy Speaker;
- (e) a deputy chairperson of the Committee of the Whole;
- (f) a chairperson of a Standing Committee of the Legislative Assembly; and
- (g) the chairperson of the general meetings for all members, referred to in paragraph 26(2)(c).

# 4. Section 28 is amended by adding the following subsections after subsection (5):

(6) Where, by virtue of a collective agreement, the rates of pay of public servants mentioned in paragraph 41(1.4)(a) of the *Public Service Act* are globally increased or decreased by a certain percentage, the Speaker, on the recommendation of the Management and Services Board, may, by regulation, increase or decrease the indemnity payable under subsection (1) by the same percentage.

(7) A regulation made under subsection (6) may come into force before the regulation is made.

#### 5. The following section is added after section 37.1:

Regulations prescribing indemnities

37.2. (1) The Speaker, on the recommendation of the Management and Services Board, may make regulations prescribing rates for the purposes of section 24.

(2) A regulation made under this section may come into force before the regulation is made.

#### 6. This Act is deemed to have come into force on April 1, 1999.
