Chapter 17

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACCESS TO INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT (CHANGE OF PRECEDENCE AND GIVING OF NOTICE) (Assented to November 3, 2000)

The Commissioner of Nunavut, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows:

1. The Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act is amended by this Act.

2. Subsection 4(3) is repealed and the following substituted:

(3) On December 31, 2002, subsection (1) is repealed and subsection (2) comes into force.

3. Section 51 is amended:

- (a) by renumbering it as subsection 51(1); and
- (b) by adding the following subsections after subsection (1):

Where notice given by mail

(2) Where notice is given by prepaid mail under paragraph (1)(a), the notice is deemed to have been given on the fifteenth day after the day on which it is mailed.

Where notice given by substitutional service

(3) Where notice is given by substitutional service under paragraph (1)(c), the notice is deemed to have been given on a day provided for by the Information and Privacy Commissioner when he or she authorized the substitutional service.
