PLEBISCITES ACT**

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TARIFF OF FEES REGULATIONS, amendment

The Management and Services Board, under subsection 217(1) of the *Nunavut Elections Act*, subsection 185(2) of the *Plebiscites Act* and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendments to the *Tariff of Fees Regulations*, Nu.Reg. R-026-2003.

1. These regulations amend the *Tariff of Fees Regulations*, Nu.Reg. R-026-2003.

2. (1) Subsection 2(1) is amended

- (a) **in the part preceding paragraph (a) by adding "for a constituency with only one community," after "appointed under the *Nunavut Elections Act*";**
- (b) **in paragraph (b) by**
 - (i) **replacing "\$12,000" with "\$13,000", and**
 - (ii) **replacing "\$6,000" with "\$6,500";**
- (c) **in paragraph (c) by replacing "\$175" with "\$187"; and**
- (d) **in paragraph (d) by replacing "\$350" with "\$375".**

(2) The following is added after subsection 2(1):

(2) A returning officer appointed under the *Nunavut Elections Act* for a constituency with two or more communities is entitled to be paid as follows:

- (a) a monthly retainer of \$100 per month during the term of his or her office;
- (b) a flat rate of \$14,500 for all work performed during the period commencing three weeks before the beginning of an election period and ending one week after the election period, or a flat rate of \$7,250 for this period if the candidate is elected by acclamation;
- (c) a payment of \$187 for any period of work of four hours or less performed at the request of the Chief Electoral Officer during a day outside the period referred to in paragraph (b); and
- (d) a payment of \$375 for any period of work of more than four hours performed at the request of the Chief Electoral Officer during a day outside the period referred to in paragraph (b).

3. Section 3 is repealed and replaced by:

(1) An assistant returning officer appointed under the *Nunavut Elections Act* for a constituency with only one community is entitled to be paid as follows:

- (a) a flat rate of \$6,500 for all work performed during the election period or a flat rate of \$3,250 for this period if the candidate is elected by acclamation; and
- (b) a payment of \$275 per day for any period of work performed at the request of the Chief Electoral Officer during a day outside the period referred to in paragraph (a).

(2) An assistant returning officer appointed under the *Nunavut Elections Act* for a constituency with two or more communities is entitled to be paid as follows:

- (a) a flat rate of \$7,250 for all work performed during the election period or a flat rate of \$3,625 for this period if the candidate is elected by acclamation; and
- (b) a payment of \$275 per day for any period of work performed at the request of the Chief Electoral Officer during a day outside the period referred to in paragraph (a).

(3) An assistant returning officer appointed or designated under the *Plebiscites Act* is entitled to be paid at 50% of the rate of pay for a returning officer as set out in subsection 2.1(1) in the case of a plebiscite.

4. Section 4 is repealed and replaced by:

4. A deputy returning officer is entitled to be paid as follows:
- (a) a payment of \$335 for all work performed relating to an advance vote and an additional \$100 for conducting a mobile poll during the advance vote;
 - (b) a payment of \$127.50 for each satisfactorily completed day of elections training required by the Chief Electoral Officer; and
 - (c) a payment of \$625 on election day or plebiscite day for all additional work performed during the term of his or her office.

5. Section 5 is repealed and replaced by:

5. A poll clerk is entitled to be paid as follows:
- (a) a payment of \$275 for all work performed relating to an advance vote and an additional \$100 for conducting a mobile poll during the advance vote;
 - (b) a payment of \$127.50 for each satisfactorily completed day of elections training required by the Chief Electoral Officer; and
 - (c) a payment of \$490 on election day or plebiscite day for all additional work performed during the term of his or her office.

6. Section 6 is repealed and replaced by:

6. A supervisory deputy returning officer is entitled to be paid \$750 on election day or plebiscite day for all work performed during the term of his or her office.

7. Section 7 is repealed and replaced by:

7. A registration clerk is entitled to be paid as follows:
- (a) a payment of \$275 for all work performed during an advance vote and an additional \$100 for conducting a mobile poll during the advance vote;
 - (b) a payment of \$127.50 for each satisfactorily completed day of elections training required by the Chief Electoral Officer; and
 - (c) a payment of \$490 on election day or plebiscite day for all additional work performed during the term of his or her office.
