## MEAT INSPECTION REGULATIONS, amendment

The Commissioner, on the recommendation of the Minister, under section 25 of the *Public Health Act*, R.S.N.W.T. 1988,c.P-12, and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendments to the *Meat Inspection Regulations*.

- 1. Section 26 of the *Meat Inspection Regulations*, N.W.T. Reg. R-190-96, is repealed and replaced by:
- 26. No person shall do any of the following in any room in which a carcass or meat is chilled or in any of the processing or shipping areas of an abattoir:
  - (a) smoke, as defined in the *Tobacco Control and Smoke-Free Places Act*;
  - (b) chew tobacco;
  - (c) spit.
- 2. These regulations come into force on the same day as section 8 of the *Cannabis Statutes Amendment Act* comes into force, or if it is already in force, on the day these regulations are registered by the Registrar of Regulations.
