TRANSITIONS REGULATIONS (2010 to 2012), amendment

The Commissioner in Executive Council, under sections 203 of the *Education Act*, S.Nu. 2008, c. 15, and every enabling power, makes the attached amendments to the *Transition Regulations* (2010 to 2012), registered as regulation numbered R-014-2010.

- 1. The *Transition Regulations* (2010 to 2012), registered as regulation numbered R-014-2010, are amended by these regulations.
- 2. The title of the Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

- 3. The definition of "transition period" in section 1 is amended by striking out "2012" and substituting "2014".
- 4. Section 3 is amended by striking out "2012" and substituting "2014".
- 5. Subsection 25(4) is repealed.
- 6. Section 29 is repealed.
- 7. Section 33 is repealed on July 1, 2013.
- 8. Section 34 is repealed and the following substituted:

Annual Report of District Education Authority

- **34.** A district education authority shall make its annual reports for the 2010-2011, 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 years available to the community as required under subsection 146(2) of the new Act even though no regulations have been made in respect of that subsection.
- 9. The Regulations are amended by adding the following section:

Resolute District Education Authority Election in 2012

- **41.1** At the election to be held in 2012 for four members of the Resolute District Education Authority, the members shall be elected for either a two-year term or a one-year term as follows:
 - (a) the person who receives the highest number of votes shall hold office for two years; and
 - (b) the other three persons who are elected shall hold office for one year.
