ACCESS TO INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY REGULATIONS, amendment

The Commissioner in Executive Council, under section 73 of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act and every enabling power, orders as follows:

1. The Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Regulations, registered under the Statutory Instruments Act (Northwest Territories) as regulation numbered R-206-96, as duplicated for Nunavut by section 29 of the Nunavut Act, are amended by these regulations.

2. Schedule A is repealed and Schedule A as set out in the schedule to these regulations is substituted.

3. These regulations come into force on the day on which they are registered with the Registrar of Regulations.
