DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME REGULATIONS, 2001

The Commissioner, on the recommendation of the Minister of Justice, under section 46 of the *Interpretation Act* and every enabling power, orders as follows:

1. (1) Daylight Saving Time shall be used and observed every year between

(a) 2 a.m. on the first Sunday in April, and

(b) 2 a.m. on the last Sunday in October.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to Southampton Island and the islands adjacent to Southampton Island.

(3) In this section, "Daylight Saving Time" means the time one hour in advance of the local standard time set out in the *Interpretation Act*.

2. The *Time Zone and Daylight Saving Time Regulations*, R-045-99, are repealed.

3. These regulations come into force on the later of

(a) the time that *An Act to Amend the Interpretation Act (Time Zones)* comes into force, and

(b) the day on which they are registered with the Registrar of Regulations.
