## CAPE DORSET SPECIAL PROHIBITION ORDER

Whereas the Cape Dorset Hamlet Council has, by resolution, requested that the Minister declare that the Hamlet of Cape Dorset is a prohibited area during the special occasion of the visit of the President of France and the Prime Minister of Canada;

The Minister, under subsection 51.1(2) of the *Liquor Act* and every enabling power, orders as follows:

- 1. All that portion of Nunavut that lies within the municipal boundaries of Cape Dorset is declared to be a prohibited area for the period commencing at 12:01 a.m. on September 4, 1999 and ending at 11:59 p.m. on September 6, 1999.
- 2. No person shall, during the period referred to in section 1, consume, purchase, sell or transport liquor within the prohibited area referred to in section 1.
- **3.** These regulations apply according to their terms before they are published in the *Nunavut Gazette*.
