

Chapter 8

AN ACT TO AMEND THE JUDICATURE ACT

(Assented to June 13, 2022)

The Commissioner, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows:

1. The following is added after section 91 of the *Judicature Act*:

ENFORCEMENT OF ORDERS UNDER THE CANADIAN FREE TRADE AGREEMENT

Definition

91.1. (1) In this section, "Canadian Free Trade Agreement" means the Canadian Free Trade Agreement between the Government of Canada and the governments of all the provinces and territories effective July 1, 2017, as amended from time to time.

Meanings of words

(2) Words and expressions in this section have the same meaning as in the Canadian Free Trade Agreement.

Filing of orders under the Canadian Free Trade Agreement

(3) A certified copy of an order made by a presiding body under the Canadian Free Trade Agreement that requires the Government of Nunavut or another person to pay tariff costs or monetary penalties may be filed with the Nunavut Court of Justice.

Effect of filing

(4) From the date it is filed under subsection (3), an order has, for the purpose of enforcement, the same effect as an order of the Nunavut Court of Justice to the extent that it is authorized by the Canadian Free Trade Agreement.

Date of order – interest

(5) For the purposes of section 54, the date on which an order is filed with the Nunavut Court of Justice under subsection (3) is deemed to be the day on which the order is pronounced.
