BEER AND WINE STORE REGULATIONS, amendment

The Minister, under section 70 of the *Liquor Act*, R.S.N.W.T. 1988,c.L-9, and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendments to the *Beer and Wine Store Regulations*.

- 1. These regulations amend the *Beer and Wine Store Regulations*, C.R.Nu. R-020-2017.
- 2. Section 6 is repealed and replaced by:
- 6. During each calendar day, a person may purchase at a Beer and Wine Store up to any one of the maximum daily amounts listed in the Schedule for the municipality where the Beer and Wine Store is located.
