BEER AND WINE STORE REGULATIONS, amendment

The Minister, under section 70 of the *Liquor Act*, R.S.N.W.T. 1988,c.L-9, and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendments to the *Beer and Wine Store Regulations*.

1. **These regulations amend the *Beer and Wine Store Regulations*, C.R.Nu. R-020-2017.**
2. **Section 6 is repealed and replaced by:**
 6. During each calendar day, a person may purchase at a Beer and Wine Store up to any one of the maximum daily amounts listed in the Schedule for the municipality where the Beer and Wine Store is located.
3. **The Schedule is repealed and replaced by the Schedule in the Schedule to these regulations.**

| Rankin Inlet | (a) six litres of low alcohol content liquor; (b) three litres of low alcohol content liquor and 0.75 litres of wine; or (c) 1.5 litres of wine. |
