Chapter 10

AN ACT CONSEQUENTIAL TO THE GOVERNMENT REORGANIZATION OF 2025 (Assented to March 11, 2025)

The Commissioner, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, enacts as follows:

1. Paragraph 6(1)(b) of the *Archives Act* is repealed and replaced by:

(b) a member of the public service employed in the department responsible for public records management and appointed by the Minister responsible for public records management;

2. Subsection 2(2) of the *Co-operative Associations Act* is amended as follows:

Appointment of Supervisor

- (2) The Minister responsible for economic development may appoint a Supervisor of Cooperative Associations to carry out the duties set out in this Act.
- 3. (1) This section amends the Commissioner's Land Act.
 - (2) Section 1 is amended by adding the following definition in alphabetical order:

"authorized agent" means a person that the Commissioner has authorized to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of Commissioner's land under subsection 3(1.2); (mandataire)

(3) The following is added after subsection 3(1.1):

Authorized agents

(1.2) The Commissioner, on the recommendation of the Minister, may authorize a person, by name, or a class of members of the public service, by designation of a position, to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of Commissioner's land under subsection (1) in accordance with the regulations.

(4) Paragraph 3(2)(b) is amended as follows:

(b) signed by the Commissioner or <u>an authorized agent</u> the authorized agent of the Commissioner; and

(5) Paragraph 12(a) is repealed and replaced by:

(a) prescribing limitations and conditions on the sale, lease or other disposition of Commissioner's land by authorized agents;

- 4. The following provisions of the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief Act are amended by replacing "Minister responsible for municipal and community affairs" with "Minister responsible for the Property Assessment and Taxation Act":
 - (a) paragraph (b) of the definition of "disabled person" in section 1;
 - (b) subsection 3(1);
 - (c) subsection 3(2).
- 5. Section 24 of the *Vital Statistics Act* is amended as follows:

Births and deaths on high seas

24. On receipt from the <u>federal</u> Minister of Transport of information transmitted under the *Canada Shipping Act, 2001*, respecting the birth of a child or the death of a person on board a ship whose port of registry is in Nunavut, the Registrar General, if satisfied as to the truth and sufficiency of the particulars received, <u>shall must</u> register the birth or death.

Coming into force

- 6. (1) This Act, except sections 1 and 3, comes into force on Assent.
 - (2) Sections 1 and 3 come into force on April 1, 2025.

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
