TRANSPORTATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS REGULATIONS

The Commissioner, on the recommendation of the Minister, under sections 63 and 64 of the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act*, 1990 and every enabling power, makes the annexed *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations*.

- **1.** In these regulations, "federal regulations" means the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations* made under the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* (Canada);
- 2. Parts 1 to 9 and Schedules 1, 2 and 3 of the federal regulations, as amended from time to time, except any reference to the following, are adopted with the variations specified in sections 3 and 4 of these regulations:
 - (a) a means of transport other than a road vehicle or combination of road vehicles on a road;
 - (b) the handling of dangerous goods for the purposes of transport and the offering for transport of dangerous goods;
 - (c) reports under Part 8 of the federal regulations other than those respecting discharges or releases; and
 - (d) compensation payable by the government.
- **3.** The adopted federal regulations are varied as follows:
 - (a) "Director General", when used in the adopted federal regulations, means
 - (i) the Registrar of Motor Vehicles appointed under the *Motor Vehicles***Act, or
 - (ii) if the Registrar of Motor Vehicles is absent, incapacitated or unable to act, a Deputy Registrar of Motor Vehicles appointed under the *Motor Vehicles Act*;
 - (b) "inspector", when used in the adopted federal regulations, includes a person appointed under section 42 of the Act;
 - (c) "means of transport", when used in the adopted federal regulations, means a vehicle as defined in the Act;
 - (d) "Minister", when used in Part 2 or Schedule 2 of the adopted federal regulations, means the Minister responsible for the Act;
 - (e) "road", when used in the adopted federal regulations, means a highway as defined in the Act;
 - (f) "road vehicle", when used in the adopted federal regulations, means a vehicle as defined in the Act;
 - (g) reports under Part 8 of the adopted federal regulations respecting discharges or releases shall be made in the circumstances described in section 34 of the Act;
 - (h) emergency reports under Part 8 of the adopted federal regulations respecting discharges or releases shall be made to the 24 Hour Spill Report Line by calling (867) 920-8130.

- **4.** The adopted federal regulations do not apply to prohibit the transportation of dangerous goods in a vehicle operated by or on behalf of the Government Nunavut, a municipality or other authority having jurisdiction and control of a highway where the vehicle is engaged in
 - (a) collecting from a highway dangerous goods that have been abandoned or spilled; or
 - (b) transporting dangerous goods from a highway to a storage or disposal site after a release as defined in section 1.4 of the adopted federal regulations.
- 5. The Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations, 1991 are repealed.
