MINE HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS, amendment

The Commissioner, on the recommendation of the Minister, under section 45 of the Mine Health and Safety Act and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendment to the Mine Health and Safety Regulations, N.W.T.Reg R-125-95.

1. These regulations amend the Mine Health and Safety Regulations, N.W.T.Reg R-125-95.

2. Subsection 1.01(1) is amended by adding the following definition in alphabetical order:

"smoke" has the same meaning as in the Tobacco Control and Smoke-Free Places Act; (fumer)

3. The heading preceding section 9.29 is amended by adding "Absorption or" before "Ingestion".

4. Section 9.29 is amended by

- adding "absorption or" before "ingestion" wherever it appears; and **(a)**
- **(b)** replacing "cosmetics" with "any product onto any part of the body".

5. Subsection 11.108(4) is repealed.

6. Section 12.07 is repealed and replaced by

No person shall smoke or have an open flame in or near a fuelling station and pictograms to this effect shall 12.07. be posted in conspicuous locations.

7. Subsection 12.09(1) is amended by replacing ""No Smoking" signs" with "pictograms indicating smoking is prohibited".

Subsection 14.03(4) is amended by replacing ""NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAME" signs" with 8. "pictograms indicating smoking and open flames are prohibited".

Paragraph 14.13(c) is amended by replacing ""NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAME" signs" with 9. "pictograms indicating smoking and open flames are prohibited which are".

10. Paragraph 18.01(g) is repealed.

Transitional

11. On the coming into force of section 55 of the Tobacco and Smoking Act, introduced as Bill 57 in the Second Session of the Fifth Legislative Assembly, the definition of "smoke" in subsection 1.01(1) is amended by replacing "Tobacco Control and Smoke-Free Places Act" with "Tobacco and Smoking Act".

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
