**CAPE DORSET SPECIAL PROHIBITION ORDER**

Whereas the Cape Dorset Hamlet Council has, by resolution, requested that the Minister declare that the Hamlet of Cape Dorset is a prohibited area during the special occasion of the visit of the President of France and the Prime Minister of Canada;

The Minister, under subsection 51.1(2) of the *Liquor Act* and every enabling power, orders as follows:

1. All that portion of Nunavut that lies within the municipal boundaries of Cape Dorset is declared to be a prohibited area for the period commencing at 12:01 a.m. on September 4, 1999 and ending at 11:59 p.m. on September 6, 1999.
2. No person shall, during the period referred to in section 1, consume, purchase, sell or transport liquor within the prohibited area referred to in section 1.
3. These regulations apply according to their terms before they are published in the *Nunavut Gazette*.
