WAGES REGULATIONS

- 1. Where an employee has been recalled to work by his or her employer and the recall was not scheduled in advance, the employer shall pay to the employee compensation equivalent to four hours pay at his or her regular rate of pay whether or not the employee is called on to perform any work after reporting for work.
- 2. Where board or lodging or both are furnished by or on behalf of an employer to an employee and the arrangement is accepted by the employee, the amount by which the wages of the employee may be reduced below the minimum wage for any pay period, either by deduction from wages or by payment from the employee to the employer for board and lodging, shall not exceed
 - (a) for each meal, \$0.65; and
 - (b) for lodging, \$0.80 a day.
- 3. No employer shall reduce the wages of an employee below the minimum wage
 - (a) for providing, maintaining or laundering any uniform or article of wearing apparel required by the employer to be worn by the employee; or
 - (b) for accidental breakages by an employee of any article of property belonging to the employer. R-036-96,s.2.
- **4.** Every employer shall post and keep posted a copy of the *Labour Standards Act* and all regulations made under the Act in a conspicuous place in the establishment of the employer so that all employees may have ready access to and see them.
- **5.** The minimum rate of wages to be paid by an employer in Nunavut is \$19.00 per hour. R.R.N.W.T. 1990,c.L-7(Supp.),s.1; R-005-2020; R-035-2023.
